Meet in the car park near the football ground on the edge of Stoney Middleton. It is just 1/3rd mile from Calver Garden Centre, near Calver crossroads. A little known walk up Coombs Dale where the flora and fauna are very beautiful. Followed by a choice of refreshments at the garden centre café.

Thursday 21st November 2019: Grindleford Station

Park down Station road Grindleford (parking usually free). Meet outside the Station cafe. A lovely walk past Padley Chapel and below Padley Gorge along a good path with stunning views. A visit to the famous Station Cafe for our post walk refreshments.

Thursday December 12th 2019: Bakewell

Meeting outside the Agricultural Centre in Bakewell. A return to the walk we did 2 years ago, a circular walk rising from the Agricultural Centre up to the Trail and return.

Followed by our pre Christmas conversations at the Bakewell Pudding shop cafe.
